However, the funding which BFC has available is not expected to meet the needs of all players. BFC will make decisions regarding financial assistance in a fair and objective manner. All applications will be treated confidentially. The names of applicants and of those receiving financial assistance will not be discussed publicly, published, or posted on the BFC website.
