



ASSESSMENT POLICY

Registered players at Burnaby FC are assessed over the course of an entire program; which include the Spring season, Fall/Winter season and at the Development Centre (ages U8-U13).

Senior Staff Coaches observe players at training and games over an extended period to evaluate what is the best environment for them to be placed in from a development perspective. With the fluid roster process, players may be asked to play at different levels to closer observe them in a different playing environment. This could be a one-off session or game or possibly as a training player with long term attendance at training sessions. More information on the BFC Training Player Status can be found below.

BCSPL Training Player (from within BFC) - Registrar will send the player(s) the correct TeamSnap link to register and will notify the team manager and add the player to the team roster. Fee is \$500 per phase at BCSPL. Players are guaranteed 1 session a week. Registrar will notify kit manager but should be no need for kit as they come from a BFC HP team (may need game uniform if they play).

Division 1 (U11-U15) / Metro Training Player - Registrar will send the player(s) the correct TeamSnap link to register and will notify the team manager and add the player to the team roster. Fee is \$500 (includes HP training kit, socks, shorts, training shirt and track suit, and players are guaranteed 1 session a week. Registrar will notify kit manager to arrange for sizing.

Players U8-U13 not registered with Burnaby FC wishing to be assessed, must register for a Development Centre Program, and submit this evaluation form (Adam and Denise preparing this for website).

Players U14-U18 not registered with Burnaby FC wishing to be assessed must fill out the evaluation request form which can be found [here](#) on the Burnaby FC website.

Burnaby FC Technical Staff reserve the right to move players at a level which is in the best interest of the players' long-term development and enjoyment of the sport. All players develop at different rates, no player is ever "set" on a team or level as they may need to be moved up a level or down level to support them on their soccer journey.

Players will be given at least 6 weeks at the start of the season before a transfer between levels occurs. In instances where there is a difference in cost between levels, their registration fee will be adjusted on a prorated basis with either a refund or if the fee is higher than at an added level upon accepting the invitation to move up.
