



Kit Policy

The purpose of this document is to communicate to all officials a program to be followed by all club members and ensure consistency amongst all teams. Only "club issued and approved" gear may be worn when representing Burnaby Football Club (BFC). Players and coaches [and managers - not on field] are not permitted to wear any clothing other than BFC branded clothing.

The primary colours for BFC are Gold and Black.

Club gear and logo are only to be used on Club approved chosen brand and supplier.

The club home jersey is black and white/gold and must be worn whenever there is not a conflict with the opposing team. This is our primary uniform and brand.

Nothing is to be attached to uniforms and club specific attire unless instructed by the Club. Club specific attire is defined as:

- Club jersey, shorts & socks
- Club warm up shirts
- Club track suits
- Club back packs / bags

All outerwear/training gear (track suits, tops, pants, jackets, training shirts, shorts & socks) must follow the primary color combination. Each season, the Club will determine the styles available.

Burnaby FC operates on a two-year cycle for uniforms. All players registering for the 2023-2024 season will receive new game kit which will be worn for both the 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 season. Any player requiring a new uniform (lost, outgrown etc.) will be required to purchase a new jersey, shorts and/or socks from the Club. BFC has committed to purchasing uniforms which will have at minimum a two-year shelf life and are of the highest quality to ensure availability across the next two seasons.

If your child loses or outgrows their uniform, you can either purchase a new kit through our Kit Manager at club cost or there will be a uniform exchange night where you can possibly upgrade/trade for the appropriate size.
