

MAKING AN INSURANCE CLAIM

BC Soccer provides coverage to full member associations (Youth District and Adult Leagues) their affiliate clubs/teams and the registered players/participants within them via our <u>SBC</u> <u>Insurance</u> (broker) and Gameday (underwriter). Read the <u>BC Soccer Insurance Program</u> <u>Coverage Summary</u>. Requests for BC Soccer's Master Insurance Certificate should be made to <u>Stephen Wurz</u> or <u>Farideh Zarei</u> (please allow for a minimum of 3 business days for any changes).

Sport Accident Insurance is coverage for sanctioned practices and games. This includes items such as dental, physiotherapy, accident reimbursement, accidental death, fracture indemnity, rehabilitation indemnity, tuition fees reimbursement, emergency transportation benefit, and eyeglasses or contact lenses expense. SBC Insurance must receive notice of the accident within 30 days of the incident by completing the claim form—all documentation associated with the claim (i.e. must be submitted within 90 days of the accident).

For claims <u>after July 31st, 2023</u>, please download and complete the attached <u>claim</u> <u>form</u> (Policy #: SLE00848) and submit it to SBC Insurance at <u>claims@sbcinsurance.com</u>. Please ensure that Physician's Statement is completed, and any receipts are attached.

For claims which occurred **before July 31st, 2023,** please download and complete the attached <u>claim form</u> (please enter CAS665228-05 under GROUP POLICY No. on the claim form). Please submit your claim directly to Markel Claims at <u>canadaclaims@markel.com</u>. Should you have any questions regarding insurance coverage, please contact SBC Insurance directly.
