Travel Consent:

BFC teams on occasion will choose to travel outside of Canada to attend tournaments outside of BFC programming. Allowing your child to attend constitutes your consent for them to travel and participate in all activities. Players travel in the company and under the supervision of BFC personnel (Team Coach, Assistant Coach and Manager, as applicable).

Travel Insurance:

All members of the delegation including players, coaches, managers and parents/guardians are responsible for obtaining their own insurance coverage, including travel and medical insurance, while outside Canada.

Liability:

Burnaby FC including its staff, Board and/or team personnel such as coaches, parent drivers, chaperones and/or managers shall be held harmless from any costs, expenses, and against any and all claims, liabilities, damages, fines, penalties, in connection with the death of or injury to any person or damage to any property whatsoever, arising from any and all out of country activities.

Medical Treatment Consent:

It is BFC policy to notify a parent as soon as possible when your child is ill or needs medical attention. Where possible, tournament organizers will have first aid qualified personnel at games. In certain situations, we may be unable to contact a parent, and we must seek immediate help for your child. Our procedure is to call for emergency medical services and/or take your child to the nearest emergency medical facility.

On occasion, your child may not be ill enough to require emergency medical services; however, they may require non-prescription over-the-counter medication such as Advil, Tylenol, Gravol, Pepto-Bismol, Imodium, Claritin, etc., to relieve pain, motion sickness, diarrhea, seasonal allergies and/or other minor discomfort. If we cannot contact the parents and we need to relieve the child of these symptoms (when they are not associated with an emergency condition), our procedure would be to give your child the appropriate non-prescription over-the-counter medicine deemed necessary. Note any exceptions or drug allergies below.





For all players traveling outside Canada under 18 years of age:

I/we, as parents or guardians of the above-named player, agree to the terms stipulated in this document as stated above. Furthermore when I/we cannot be contacted by BFC personnel at the time, I/we authorize, direct and consent to BFC personnel to (1) seek emergency treatment for our child when seriously ill or injured; (2) permit any medical treatments deemed necessary by medical personnel with emergency medical services and/or at the emergency medical facility; and (3) administer appropriate non-prescription over-the-counter medicines to treat minor ailments—exceptions as noted below.
